Police precincts are being redistricted. Ours is being split at Third Avenue.

Everything south will be in the downtown precinct 16, and north of it will be in Precinct 4. Our area is the lowest in crime in the city. The entire city is being redistricted. HWS will try to have Deputy Chief Jacobs out for a meeting. We will have fewer officers in the area. FOP is not supporting the new redistricting.

Motion Ken Wightman motioned that we contact the other neighborhoods to set up community meeting with Deputy Chief Jacobs. Pastor Morris seconded it

Many felt that we needed to have a further conversation because there is a plaque dedicating the park to another person. A suggestion to rename the park Founders Park was discussed.
