Social: S. Dougherty: look for opportunities to recruit and social around Jazz Stage. Summer Block Party: do a real one this year, get proper licenses with businesses involved and has some new volunteers on committee. Do it instead of a meeting or on National Night Out on August 5th (Tuesday) could move meeting then too. K. Day could have on the patio or shut down a street. Could do on 2nd between Oregon and Michigan. Have in residential area or Perry between 3rd & 4th with Batelle green space or 4th Ave east of Pennsylvania. Aiming for 2nd (Kristen's block as she will get signatures). Children's Marathon on 10/19 coming through Harrison West set up a cheering station.

Parks: B. Mangia: parks@harrisonwest.org Dog areas flipped at Wheeler, water needs fixed. City mulched at Harrison West Park. Side by Side weeded, damage to ballard and light post in the park, City is aware and making some implementations. Committee met with Alan McKnight and discussed Gowdy Field \$ to discuss recommendations: (1) community gardens (City won't do in parks), church lot at 1st does not want a community garden, so taking off list as has no champion. (2) Met with Tina Moen of Rec & Parks and Sewer and Drains to talk about end of 2nd as boat portage. Rec & Parks like the idea for kayaks and canoes for neighborhood. Thinks it is a good access point. Clean up Harrison West Park next Wed. on 5/28 and on 5/31 in Harrison Park south end. K. Day would like to have community clean-up day around the bus stop and bushes near bus stop. Easterday question: items of safety hazards (condoms, needles) what should be done? Zeno's parking lot. Customers from both businesses park there and serves neighborhood. Flood lights to be put in. Sandy and Kathleen will discuss the parking lot. Trash and safety both on private parking lot, might include a cleanup. Bob suggestion: cut back bushes more in the fall. Hard to get folks to clean up parks but because on private property the landlords need to be responsible. Kathleen to organize something offline and society will help promote. Short North Foundation: J. Bergadine: SN Alliance Summer Sale on 7/19. Proceeds from Gala used to create a more interactive website. SNCA movies in Goodale Park series. VV yard sale 6/7. 40th Home Tour in September. Grant applications out so requests for funding through SNF (DL: 7/1/14) to be reviewed for things benefitting SN neighborhoods (parks, Jazz Series, etc). What is role of foundation? Fiscal agent for other organizations. How can they be a catalyst to bring groups together in a meaningful way: community plan for future development, architectural guidelines, strategies to move neighborhood forward cohesively, etc. SNA wants to involves Exec Committees from each neighborhood to provide input. In beginning stages of coordination. UIRF: City has list and will return soon for prioritization
