Minutes: April minutes, S. Dougherty motioned, J Bergandine second PASSED

President's Report: K. Easterday. 2 requests for funding: Goodale Park Music Series & Harrison West Jazz Stage. \$500 traditionally given to Goodale Park except last year \$250 each to Goodale and Jazz Stage. Goodale asked for \$500. Harrison West Jazz Stage has levels (\$1,000, \$500, \$250). Much better financial place than last year. Open to discussion. (Mark Subel left room for discussion). Dean Curry, agree we can give more than last year. Do we have any significant expenses? Art insurance (about \$800). \$500 sets a precedent. Any anticipated party costs? No, mostly donated. M. Williams: going to be asking to feed volunteers and insurance may go up. At \$500 last time, possibly double. Consensus: give more to HWJS, how much in total to spend \$1,000? Comfortable with at least \$500 for HWJS. Treasurer: can afford \$1,000, but tricky to forecast for future years. J Bergandine: maybe be more conservative and spend \$750. Short North Civic Association does not support HWJS. M Williams MOTION: \$300 toGPMS and \$500 to HWJS D. Burke 2nd PASSED Treasurer's Report: T. Price: \$3,363.86 in checking \$43.09 in paypal \$3,406.95

Curry: stop sign at 2nd and Perry who to contact to rearrange them? Can we do the traffic study now? Ask Rob Harris.
