Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM by Tim Price President **Quorum** present **Presiding:** Tim Price

Minutes: February minutes. **MOTION to approve C. Ruder; M. Williams Second PASSED**

President's Report: T. Price: potential proposal for 2nd & Perry still TBD. SN Parking Study Meeting, 2 parts affect HW: (1) variance zoning potentially charge for additional parking spaces (trying to exclude HW from that part of project – other neighborhood leaders in favor of inclusion). HW would still be recommender of variances if (2) permit parking everywhere in the neighborhood (\$100/year per resident – eligible for 2 per household – guests passes still TBD); also test parking kiosks for every 10-15 spaces (makes parking variable – change rates and time limits), removes meters – pilot on High Street near Goodale and Park Street. Double headed meters. Pilot new parking signs to make easier. Battelle green space: narrowed down to 3 developers, no one picked yet, no concept, still want input, interest in housing and business incubator. No interest shown in selling any part to HWS. Elections next month if you want to nominate anyone for an office.

Treasurer's Report: A. Ruenzi: \$5,107.34 in account; but bills to pay over next few months, good dues income; need to have the audit

Development: no report

Parks and Green Space: B. Mangia: talked to Steve Stivers, reiterated what T. Price said. Tony Collins of Rec & Parks says green space can't be buried in the development. Earth Day Cleanup spearheaded by Matt Wolfe & Matthew Williams on bike trail to 3rd to Goodale. Side by Side Park cleanup 6-7:30 on 4/27 at the Park for Cocktails & Cleanup then Saturday 4/30 from 9-11AM final touches. Harrison Park boat portage work begun, river bank scraped and wild flowers planted on west side. Wheeler Park, maybe mid-May to be reopened. Still need volunteers: adopt a bed, get to know neighbors parks@harrisonwest.org; help with Harrison West Jazz Stage 9/11, 18, 25 + 10/2. Clean up after your dogs. This Friday IBS will be hosting an electronics drop off. KT: bathroom and food truck issues

Membership: D. Curry: current total 83 people (can do better). Has reached out to previous but non-current members; doing OK financially because of updated dues structure, but numbers reduced; ask your neighbors to join; get word out; welcome packet to new neighbors; membership important for City clout
