Harrison West Society Meeting ~ April 17, 2019

Meeting called to order at 7:01 PM at Harrison Park Community Center Quorum Present

Presiding: Tim Price, President

Minutes: Motion to approve March minutes by Z. Nelson, Second by D. Carey, minutes PASSED.

Matt Wolf - Neighborhood Clean-Ups:

President's Report: T. Price.

Treasurer's Report: Z. Nelson. We have \$7,640.02 in the bank.

TIFF Update: D. Carey. TIF takes a portion of the property tax from the area that it covers that can be spent on certain items: parks, etc. Reached out to City to see if TIF \$ would be part of it. City decided to spend \$1.2mi on acquisition of parkland. Want to know how that decision is made and convey neighborhood preferences on how \$ is spent. Assemble a list of priorities and pass along to the City. Sidewalk repair not applicable, but construction of new sidewalks possible. \$1.5mi left in the TIF.

Development: D. Carey. **Presentation:** Zeno's revisiting the patio project. Need blessing of HWS on project started 10 years ago. Timeline this summer. Original architectural drawing allows for a nine two-tops. Dimensions for amount of sidewalk required to maintain. Timeframe for allowing people outside? Are their guidelines? Depends on relationship with the neighborhood. Keeping it more to corner of 3rd. Daytime/happy hour focused. Will comply with noise issues from neighborhood. Issues from past (1) going down Pennsylvania, (2) trees along the side impacted passageway. Proposal to put greenspace further down PA side. Want to not disrupt the neighborhood. How to proceed: HWS votes on zoning issues/variances. Starts with meeting with Executive Committee then goes to full Society. Dimensions: 5'4" inside on PA side, 3rd Ave. 5'4". There was a tree at 3rd but it has been removed for the light posts. Seeking letter of recommendation from HWS. Consideration: get updated plans to be distributed in advance to prepare people for the meeting. Fence wraps around most of the front of 3rd to the staircase on Pennsylvania.

Short North Foundation: J. Hinderliter, an alleyway on corner of 5th and High on the west side is still a high crime area. SNF approved funds to try to beautify and light the alley better. Going to put up barriers to block traffic from entering from 5th. Parking plan is not going ideally. A lot of complaints from businesses about walk up traffic being impacted. Meeting tomorrow at Goodale Park Caretaker's Residence. City will reassess some of the parking in May. Feedback is that businesses think that's too far and want relaxation of parking restrictions and costs during the day. K. Wightman: parking czar met with Dennison Place: parking is not being adequately utilized. Potential second guest permit to residents. No business using the paid pass. Parking being overutilized at the boundaries where there is no parking plan. Nextdoor discussions about University, German Village, etc.
