Have Gowdy Field and UIRF funds available. City: Molly says they are working on plans for the boat portage and plans for HW Park. Transferred \$30,000 into public art fund for HWS. Clean up after your dogs. Wheeler Park: both sides closed because grass is damaged. Heavily used park. Plan to re-open other side when it is available and grass has grown.
