Harrison West Society Meeting ~ July 18, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM at Harrison Park Community Center **Quorum Present Presiding:** Tim Price, President

Minutes: Motion to approve June minutes by Z. Nelson, Second by D. Carey, minutes PASSED.

President's Report: T. Price, **Motion: by M. MacDonald Gretchen James requesting a letter of support for placing Mary Funk in the Columbus Hall of Fame. Second by B. Mangia PASSED (unanimous).** Request from Vermont Place for permit parking. Have a greater neighborhood discussion about parking.

Development: D. Carey. **Presentation: by Sandra LaFontaine** signage proposal for Eye and Ear building on Olentangy River Rd. eliminating DNA band and adding the block O to the signage. Slightly over the SF permitted total zoning allows 624SF and 881 SF requested. 409 SF on NW corner while zoning allows 208 SF. **Motion: by D. Carey to approve the proposal as submitted second by B. Waldmann-Hinderliter PASSED.** Wagenbrenner got the extension through the end of the year.

Presentation: by Tina Thomas-Manning Executive Director of Inspire Elementary Charter School. Grades K-3 (hope to grow each year). City of Columbus ensuring appropriate permits. 27 years as an educator. Looking forward to joining the neighborhood and bringing education to the Short North. Capacity of 550 in the building. Start small and grow slowly. 30 families interested right now. Less than \$7,000 per pupil from the state. Buckeye Community Hope sponsoring. Lives in the Short North and vested in the community. Leasing from the new owner.

Officer Smith: mostly theft related (patio furniture, etc), zone investigators in charge of all misdemeanor crime investigations and they have a lot on their plate.

Treasurer's Report: Z. Nelson. We have \$5613.36 in the bank. Donated \$700 to the Jazz Stage.

Parks: B. Mangia, Harrison West Park on Wednesday, July 25 from 6-7:30PM and Saturday, July 28 from 9-11AM. Please pick up after dogs and if you have questions: parks@harrisonwest.org. Make sure you take care of your flower beds. City proposal to put a sewer outlet at the end of 2nd Avenue similar to Neil Avenue at Spruce and Vine (wrought iron fence around it) in park where sycamore sculpture is now. Would lose access to north end of the park for 3 years. Request to Tina Mowen to move it to south end of the park. Tunnel to alleviate runoff from storm water. Projected start date 2020.

Membership: C. Young. No report.

Short North Foundation: D. Carey. Kaufman IBEW project off (either temporarily or permanently) claims he is moving on (but he owns the land). Vic Village Commission didn't have the votes to pass so it was tabled. One Italian Village Commissioner who has been cautious about maintaining the historic character of the neighborhood was told that he is not being invited to renew his term. He will be replaced by someone who does not live in the neighborhood. It's already hard to find qualified folks to sit on it as it's an unpaid position.
