Call to order: Michael Metz called to order at 7:03:pm.

President's Report president@harrisonwest.org: introductions. Thanksgiving next week. 12/3 Exec meeting, 2nd floor. December meeting will be our holiday party, Dec 17th.

Minutes: – Motion by Travis, Bob 2nd, approved.

Treasurer: \$3,408.80. Spent \$649 in October for insurance and website. Spent about \$1k grant money on party between food, door hangers, etc. Renew your membership, get 14 months for the price of 12.

Parks and Greenspace Report parks@harrisonwest.org: Good news, beaver took out 2 pear trees in Harrison Park. City has planted 25 new trees from 2nd to Quality Place. Larger trees with a nice mix of various trees beside the traditional trees. Will talk to Jenny regarding MOUs on 12/1. Overview of the MOU request: wants the Society to sign a memorandum of understanding about what we're responsible for and the city is responsible for. Things like chemicals (no), overhauling beds, etc. Can be as detailed as possible. Just the first conversation on how specific we must be, how much we must take on etc. We need to coordinate with the city on events that involve the parks and the MOU. Not policing anything, just guidelines between us and the city. Trees in front Lucky's disappeared, city is aware. They weren't properly planted. Please clean up after your dogs. Sewer project update: Rumpke having issues at Harrison Park. Good progress, site area still messy. Pipe is done, working on air vent pipe, should be done next week. Intersection should reopen in early 2026. Final roadway construction begins in the spring.

Membership membership@harrisonwest.org: Reminder sent out in newsletter for November.

Short North Foundation: Surprising meeting: wanted endowment spent. The remainder of the endowment will be given to the Friends of Goodale Park. SNF still a 501C and can help with grants, etc. but that grant is gone. Survey of Short North marker signs was done by SNF and they wanted to see if any of the signs in the neighborhood needed redoing. Sent information about a couple of signs, one in Side-by-side. Maybe add one by Lucky's and in the future at 1st, 3rd, 5th, etc.

Art: Not in attendance.

Block Watch blockwatch@harrisonwest.org: 1 assault, 1 commercial burglary, 7 thefts from motor vehicle, 1 residential burglary, 3 damaged vehicles, 1 felony assault, and 3 thefts. Swat incident on Michigan, not on list. Should we post the data to the web, could it be counter to folks hearing about the neighborhood. We can talk about it. Officer Hauenstein with updates around the neighborhood. 10/24 at 8:53pm armed robbery on 1st. Firearm recovered somewhat away. Suspect was arrested and charges are forthcoming. CPD is still looking for 2 suspects. 10/27 10:02pm, 1151 N High for a fight. N 4th Street armed robbery and stolen vehicle, detective assigned. Robbery at UDF, female stole alcohol and fled onto 1st Ave. 11/15 robbery at UDF. 11/17 responded to Smith Place, someone walked out of a residential basement. Suspect was located at Dennison and 6th. Charged with burglary. 11/18 6:13pm, shooting at 1160 N High Street, multiple gunshot wounds, transported to OSU. Verbal argument started at Rock City Church and ended at Stonewall Columbus. Suspect taken into custody, searched their apartment and recovered a firearm.
